
Dear Sister Columbiettes,

Hi everyone, hope everyone is well and have been enjoying their Summer with family and friends.




The summer is soon coming to an end and we will be starting our new Columbian year.

2) The 100th anniversary for the council: Nick and I were discussing having a fund raiser and inviting the new pastor to the event.


3) Nick has also arranged with Father Rowan having a memorial mass on Sunday November 10th at 12:30


(Continued from page 1) you talk to God. Here, you will spend One minute on each person of the Trinity:
